Who is CSIA?

Originally a North American organization, founded in 1994, with the aim to promote the field of 'System Integration' and bring it to a higher level.

Why yet another quality mark?

Since 2001, companies can become certified. A few years ago, this quality mark was introduced in the Netherlands by FEDA, also to promote the field in the Netherlands 'System Integration' and bring it to a higher level.

What does it add, compared to other quality labels?

The quality criteria are specifically tailored to the system integrators business, this in contrast to e.g. an ISO9001 quality system. The quality criteria are also objective, defined by an umbrella organization rather than the company itself.







Whereupon is a certified company assessed?

Certification takes place by means of quality criteria that are based on the CSIA's best practices manual. The System Integrator will be assessed on:

- 1. General Management
- 2. Human Resource Management
- 3. Marketing, Business Development and Sales Management
- 4. Financial Management
- 5. Project Management
- 6. System Development Lifecycle
- 7. Supporting activities
- 8. Quality Management
